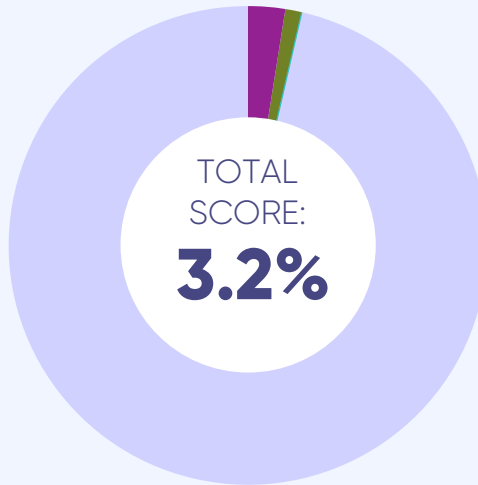

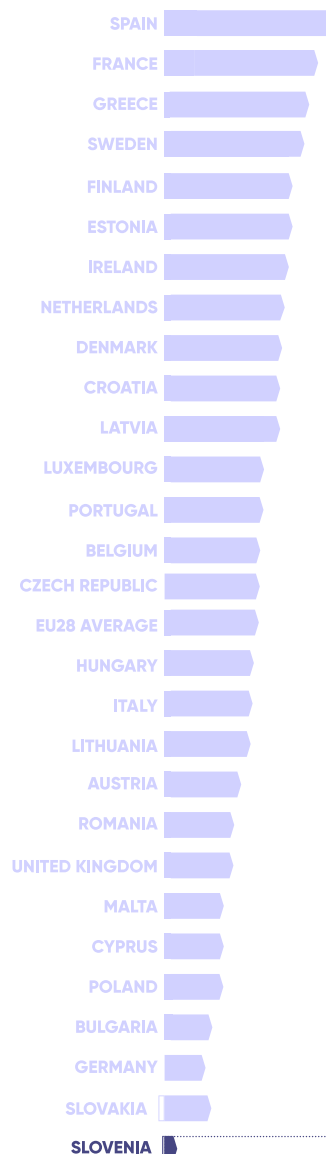

- ✓ The draft NECP includes some reference to the long-term strategy and the Paris Agreement.
- ✗ The plan does not provide an energy efficiency target and it has no adequate inclusion of the 2050 dimension.
- ✗ Slovenia has set low targets for non-ETS emissions and renewable energy.
- ✗ The draft plan does not provide information on planned policies and measures to tackle non-ETS emissions or energy efficiency.
- ✗ It does not provide information about the required investments nor the required financing measures up to 2030.
- ✗ The plan does not include information on phasing out coal or fossil fuel subsidies.
- ✗ No dedicated consultation was undertaken for the draft plan.



This scorecard is the outcome of a ranking exercise of the draft National Energy and Climate Plans (NECPs) of the 28 EU Member States. It is based on the information provided directly in the draft NECPs.

The underlying assessment focuses on three core dimensions: the adequacy of the communicated climate and energy targets, the detail of the policy descriptions, and the quality of the NECP drafting process.

It is not a full impact assessment and does not evaluate the likely effectiveness of the presented existing or additional policies or the accuracy of the information provided.
